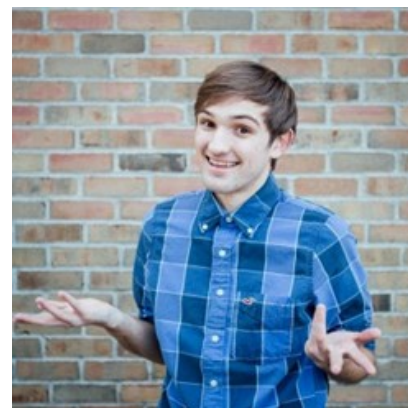

It's always a fun time and they were hard at work with smiles.

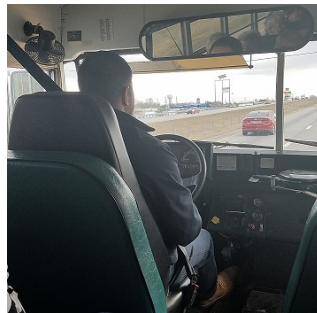

## Wednesday Night Youth Group

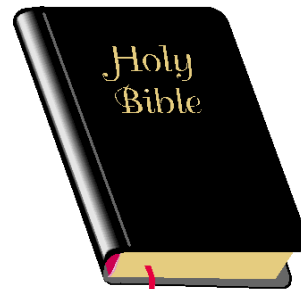
