The Pace of Jesus

Recently, a *Renovare* weekly newsletter included three different articles about the pace of Jesus. I am going to give you an excerpt from each of the articles for you to ponder.

Katelyn Dixon in an article entitled “Living at the Speed of Jesus” wrote:

What if the whole time I thought I was learning to wait, I was actually learning to *live*—slowly, intentionally, creatively — at the pace God created me to live? I wonder if instead of me waiting for God’s divine pre-packaged life plan to arrive on my doorstep, God was actually waiting for *me* to learn that life with Him is simultaneously much simpler and much richer than I could have imagined. Maybe God was inviting me to catch up to his pace — which means slowing down.

After all, how fast did Jesus move while he lived among us? He moved at the speed of walking.

Jesus only moved and acted at the intentional pace of the Spirit and the pleasure of the Father — which is to say, Jesus moved at the speed of Triune relationship. After the Pharisees accuse Jesus of breaking the Sabbath by healing a paralyzed man, Jesus tells them he was simply acting in utter dependence upon his Father. **Very truly I tell you, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing, because whatever the Father does the Son also does....**

Chris Hall in an article entitled “Some Things Take Time” wrote:

The wisest, time-tested pattern for change seems to be slow assimilation; we allow a truth to stew in our mind and heart, to percolate in our brain and body, refusing to sprint toward change. In spiritual formation, God offers us a marathon much more often than a one-hundred-yard dash.

Richard Foster in an article entitled “Waiting on the Lord Involves... Waiting” wrote:

The post-modern person is addicted to haste, hurry, hustle. And the addiction shrivels our soul. Our desperate need today is for a time-full life. When we are fractured and fragmented with “muchness” and “manyness” we cannot experience a time-full life. When we chaff under the “slowness” of our microwaves and our computers it becomes nearly impossible for us to obey the divine Whisper, “Be still and know that I am God” (Ps. 46:10). Some things simply will not yield to our perpetual hankering for the instant, the immediate, the sudden. Surely the growth of our soul before God is one of those things.

Time ... time and space ... time and space and stillness ... these are the tools God uses to build a patient endurance within us. One of the most repeated counsels given in Scripture is the simple admonition to “Wait upon the Lord.”

Could it be that we are outrunning God? Could our outbursts of frustration, our fatigue, our stress-filled anxiety, and so much more all be caused by our out pacing Jesus? We have an interesting statement of purpose, “To follow Jesus Christ through the wind of the Holy Spirit.” To follow someone, you need to stay behind. In the words of my car driving wisdom to my family in the past, “You can’t drive quicker than the one in front of you.” Crashes are bound to happen if you do. To follow Jesus, we must go his pace.

Emergency supplies are needed
You can provide relief today.

MCC recently sent five containers of relief supplies to Ukraine, and is planning another shipment for later this year. There is an increased demand for supplies to send to Ukraine and other countries around the world.

Our inventory of material resources is getting low.

We will begin collecting donations in August and continue to receive donations until September 11. (an example of items are on display in the Narthex)

Here is a list of items needed:

Contents (NEW items only)

- 4 large bars bath soap (leave in wrapper)
- Shampoo (1 or 2 bottles, totaling more than 20 oz; place in resealable plastic bag)
- 4 large bars laundry soap (such as Fels Naptha®, Sunlight® or Zote® brands)
- 4 adult-size toothbrushes (in manufacturer's packaging)
- 4 new bath towels (medium weight, dark or bright colors; approx. 29 in x 60 in)
- 2 wide-toothed combs (6–8 in)
- 1 nail clipper (good quality)
- 1 box adhesive bandages (minimum 40, assorted)
- Sanitary pads (**THIN**; 1 or 2 packages, Minimum 28 pads total)

Shepherds learned four leadership functions and were encouraged to go beyond PACE (**P**ray, be **A**vailable, **C**ontact and be a good **E**xample)

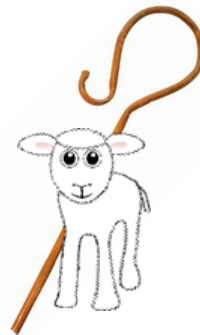
Shepherds were encouraged to provide spiritual direction for their sheep.
