He whispered, "My precious child, I love you and will never leave you
Never, ever, during your trials and testings.
When you saw only one set of footprints, It was then that I carried you."

That is the final stance of the poem "Footprints in the Sand." There is no doubt that God's love is unfailing, but could it be that the writer of the "Footprints in the Sand" misinterpreted what the Lord had said? Could it be that the reason for only one set of footprints in the sand was not the Lord carrying him, but that God had stopped walking with him? Why would the Lord stop walking with a person? Because the person stopped walking with the Lord.

Could it be that in the Garden of Eden there were three sets of footprints before Adam and Eve ate from tree of knowledge of good and evil, but after they rebelled, there were only two, two sets of footprints that went into hiding?

Could it be that the path where the prodigal son walked only had one set of footprints, after all the Father stayed home?

King Asa of Judah had just defeated the Cushites. God had given King Asa a great victory. The Lord sent a prophet named Azariah to King Asa. The prophet encouraged the king to follow the Lord. He began with these words: "The Lord is with you when you are with him. If you seek him, he will be found by you, but if you forsake him, he will forsake you" (2 Chronicles 15:2-3). Did you read those words, "The Lord is with you when you are with him"? Thus, the prophet was telling the king, "If you want to know the presence of the Lord, be where he is. Seek him!" In other words, don't expect to experience the presence of the Lord if you are walking in rebellion against him, if you are walking in sin. Return to him.

The prophet Azariah wasn't making things up in his mind. He probably knew the words of Deuter-onomy- the words of the Law - "But if from there you seek the Lord your God, you will find him if you look for him with all your heart and with all your soul. When you are in distress and all these things have happened to you, then in later days you will return to the Lord your God and obey him. For the Lord your God is a merciful God; he will not abandon or destroy you or forget the covenant with your forefathers, which he confirmed to them by oath" (Deut. 4:29-31).

The people of Israel were invited to seek the Lord and walk with him. We are invited to seek the Lord. May we see two sets of footprints. (See the August spiritual exercise for more passages about seeking the Lord.)

If you see one set of footprints, beware and begin to seek. If you don't seek, remember Azariah's words, "If you forsake him, he will forsake you."
 Or, in the words of the apostle Paul, "If we disown him, he will also disown
us" (2 Tim. 2:12). Or, even in the words of Jesus, "But whoever disowns me before men, I will disown before my Father" (Matthew 10:33).

King Saul rebelled against God and the Spirit of the Lord left him; from that point there was one set of footprints. As Jonah headed to Tarshish, there was only one set of footprints. Jesus invited people to follow him, and some did not; they only saw one set of footprints.

My friends, I want you to see two sets of footprints. In a paraphrase of an old gospel song, I want you walk with him and talk with him. I want him to tell you that you are his own. In other words, I want you to be with him. Seek Jesus! Follow Jesus! Enjoy Jesus!
