Thank you: God for answering my prayers and my parents for their support and advice.



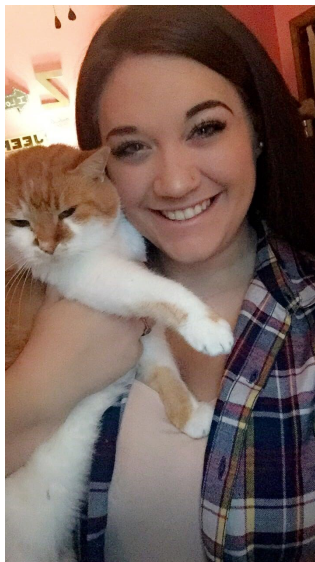
## Sarah Johnson
