His call to youth ministry emerged during his senior year of high school and Lyle was encouraged to pursue his passion by his mentor, Jacob Harrison, who was then the Pastor to Students and Outreach at Hollowell. Jacob offered Lyle opportunities to serve in teaching and in coordinating events.

“My walk with Christ truly began the summer before my freshman year of high school. It was at an event run by a youth ministry called Salt N Light. There, Christianity became real for me, not just a reason I need to go to church on Sundays. People prayed over me; not just pastors for ceremony – but friends, because they cared about me.” Lyle’s life was changed by that event and he realized that the community of fellowship and love he experienced was something he wanted to be a part of and he committed his life to Christ.

Lyle is currently involved in a drama ministry called Transformed and a campus ministry – Cru – where he holds a leadership role.

Through this internship, Lyle hopes to gain experience and knowledge that will help guide his future in ministry. For now, he simply knows that he wants to follow his ministry calling and he is anxious to learn more about roles in the church, administration, even the technical side of ministry to help him get a better idea of what his future may hold.
