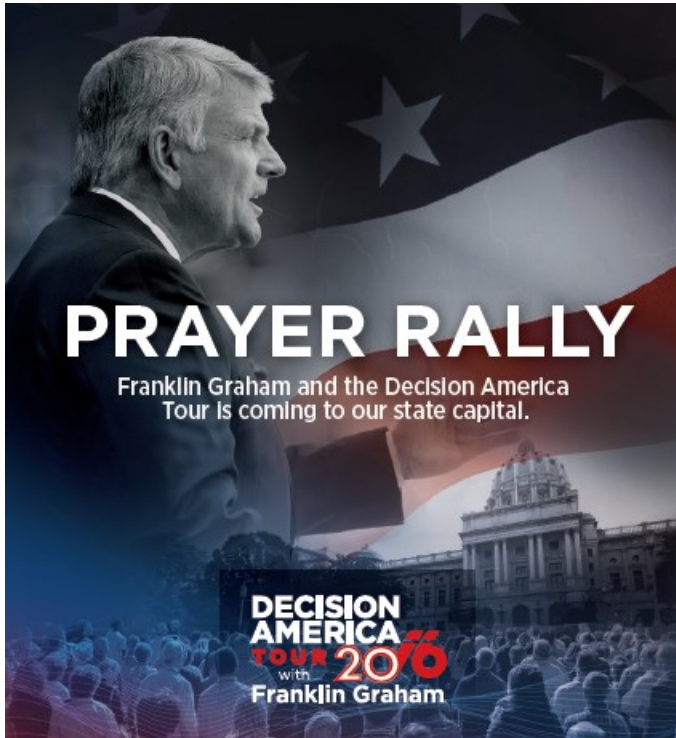

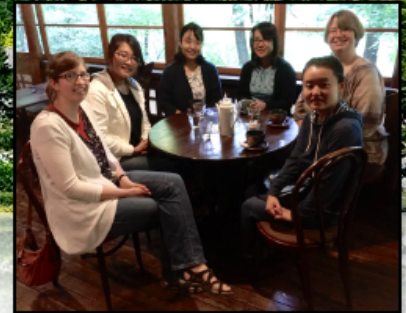
Here's an exciting story...

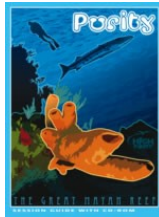
